DECLARATION OF RESCISSION OF EMERGENCY SLOW-NO-WAKE ZONES ON CRYSTAL LAKE

Heavy rainfall in the Dane County area resulted in high water levels on local lakes in 2008. Pursuant to Ch. 72 of the Dane County Ordinances, the County Executive, with the approval of the Sheriff and the County Board Chair declared an Emergency Slow-No-Wake Zone on the entire surface area of Crystal Lake located in Dane County on June 10, 2008. Columbia County also declared the portion of Crystal Lake located in Columbia County to be a slow-no-wake-zone.

Since June 2008, water levels on Crystal Lake have declined to levels that justify the rescission of the slow-no-wake zone. Further, local roads have been raised to provide for safe transportation. The Town of Roxbury and the County of Columbia are in support of rescinding the slow-no-wake zone.

Based upon the foregoing, the County of Dane hereby declares that effective as of sunrise on June 23, 2012, the previously issued Declaration of Emergency Slow-No-Wake Zone on the entire surface area of Crystal Lake located in Dane County is rescinded, and safe normal boating may be resumed.
