## DECLARATION OF EMERGENCY SLOW NO WAKE ZONE ON LAKE KEGONSA

Recent heavy rainfall has resulted in high water levels on Lake Kegonsa. The high water levels pose a significant threat to shoreline erosion and damage to property.

Section 72.08(3)(a) of the Dane County Code of Ordinances authorizes the County Executive, with the approval of the Sheriff and the County Board Chair to declare all or any portion of the surface area of Lakes Mendota, Monona, Waubesa and Kegonsa as a slow-no-wake zone during periods of high water posing a threat to life or property. As of June 28, 2013 the level of Lake Kegonsa poses a substantial risk to property and public safety.

The County of Dane hereby declares effective immediately, the entire surface area of Lake Kegonsa to be a slow-no-wake zone. Slow-no-wake speed is defined as the minimum speed at which motorized watercraft is able to move and maintain steerage.

Unless extended by subsequent declaration due to continued high water conditions, the slow-no-wake restriction on Lake Kegonsa will expire at sunrise on July 4, 2013.

Violation of the slow-no-wake restriction is subject to punishment by citation and forfeiture.
