- 1. All plans must be prepared by a professional engineer registered in the state of Wisconsin under ch. 443, Wis. Stats., or by an agricultural engineering practioner certified under ch. ATCP 50.46, Wis. Admin. Code.
- 2. No work shall start until a manure storage facility closure permit has been issued by the department.
- 3. The LWRD will issue a letter to the landowner confirming that the manure storage facility has been closed in accordance with the applicable standards once as-built documentation has been submitted to the department.
