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1. Construction plans, specifications, and documentation prepared in accordance with NRCS Standard 360.			
2. Provisions to remove and properly dispose of all accumulated wastes in the manure storage facility.			
3. Provisions to remove any concrete or synthetic liner, or to properly use the concrete liner as clean fill at the site.			
4. Provisions to remove any soils, to the depth of significant manure contamination, from the bottom and sides of the manure storage facility.			
5. Provision to remove or permanently plug the waste transfer system serving the manure storage facility.			
6. Provisions to grade, shape, fill, cover disturbed areas with topsoil, seed, and mulch the area affected by the manure storage closure.			
7. Construction inspection plan defining all the work items that require verification prior to proceeding with construction.

Note:

1. All plans must be prepared by a professional engineer registered in the state of Wisconsin under ch. 443, Wis. Stats., or by an agricultural engineering practitioner certified under ch. ATCP 50.46, Wis. Admin. Code.
2. No work shall start until a manure storage facility closure permit has been issued by the department.
3. The LWRD will issue a letter to the landowner confirming that the manure storage facility has been closed in accordance with the applicable standards once as-built documentation has been submitted to the department.
